ORDINANCE 21-08
(Stevenson / Capital Reef Management LLC Annexation)

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING REAL PROPERTIES LOCATED AT APPROXIMATELY 950 SOUTH AND 1700 WEST INTO THE CITY AND EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF LAYTON CITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the properties located at approximately 950 South and 1700 West are part of an existing unincorporated parcel of property contiguous to Layton City; and

WHEREAS, these properties are identified in the Layton City Annexation Policy Plan, Expansion Area Five, adopted by the City Council on December 5, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution 21-14 expressing Layton City's intent to annex said properties; and

WHEREAS, a plat of said real properties has been prepared under the supervision of a competent surveyor, showing the size and location of said real properties and showing that the same is contiguous to the present corporate limits of Layton City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that in their judgment, this annexation meets the standards set forth in the Utah State Code, and the noticing requirements therein have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, the Layton City Council deems it to be in the best interest of the City and its citizens to annex the real property described herein to Layton City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LAYTON, UTAH:

SECTION I: Repealer. If any provisions of the City's Code heretofore adopted are inconsistent herewith they are hereby repealed.

SECTION II: Enactment. That the following described real property is hereby annexed into Layton City, and the corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include said real property:

A parcel of land, situated in the Southwest Quarter of Section 30, Township 4 North, Range 1 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, said parcel also located in Davis County, Utah. Being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the northerly right-of-way line of 1700 West Street, said point being South 89°57'40" West 591.29 feet along the section line (NAD83 Basis of Bearing being North 89°41'53" West between the South Quarter Corner and Southwest Corner of Section 30 according to the Davis County Township Reference Plat) and North 00°02'20" West 93.32 feet from the South Quarter Corner of said Section 30 and running thence: North 46°34'05" West 180.86 feet; thence North 00°12'50" East 835.01 feet; thence South 36°41'00" East 769.41 feet; thence South 43°25'20" West 418.09 feet; thence Southwesterly 58.68 feet along the arc of a 317.00-foot radius tangent curve to the right (center bears North 46°34'41" West and the long chord bears South 48°43'29" West 58.60 feet with a central angle of 10°36'20") to the Point of Beginning.

Contains: 273,131 square feet or 5.444 acres ±

SECTION III: Filing. The City Recorder is directed to file a certified copy of the plat of said real property and a certified copy of this ordinance of annexation with the Davis County Recorder; and within 60 days after the enactment hereof, the City Council shall file with the Lieutenant Governor a notice of impending boundary action, as defined in Section 67-1a-6.5 UCA that meets the requirements of Section 67-1a-6.5(3) UCA and a copy of an approved final plat, as defined in Section 67-1a-6.5.

SECTION IV: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, said portion shall be severed and such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the said ordinance.

SECTION V: Effective date. This ordinance shall go into effect at the expiration of the 20th day after publication or posting or the 30th day after final passage as noted below or whichever of said days is more remote from the date of passage thereof.

RESOLUTION 21-14
(Stevenson Annexation Petition)

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A PETITION FOR ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT APPROXIMATELY 950 SOUTH 1700 WEST

WHEREAS, a petition has been received by Layton City, pursuant to Utah Code Annotated section 10-2-403, petitioning for annexation of certain properties located at approximately 950 South 1700 West; and

WHEREAS, these properties are located within an area where Layton City can provide urban services; and

WHEREAS, these properties are identified in the Layton City Annexation Policy Plan, Expansion Area Five, adopted by the City Council on December 5, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determines it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Layton City to accept the petition for annexation and direct staff to certify the annexation petition and provide notice thereof relative to the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the property owners wish to proceed with the petition for annexation to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LAYTON, UTAH:

1. The City has received a petition for annexation presented by Brad Frost with Capital Reef Management LLC, owners of approximately 5.44 acres, located at approximately 950 South 1700 West.

2. The above properties, more particularly described in 'Exhibit A' which is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, represents one hundred percent (100%) of the private land and constitutes one hundred percent (100%) of the value of all private property within the area proposed for annexation.

3. The petition is hereby accepted by the City based on the understanding that development improvement obligations will be fulfilled by the applicant for a previous annexation agreement and development approval in Layton.
