RESOLUTION NO. 2025-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE JOINT BOARD CREATED UNDER UTAH LAW AND AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT, APPROVING THE OFFICIAL NAME CHANGE OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT FROM CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT TO ASPEN PEAKS SCHOOL DISTRICT, CERTIFYING THE NAME CHANGE IN ACCORDANCE WITH UTAH CODE § 67-1a-6.7, AND AUTHORIZING RELATED ACTIONS WITHIN THE BOARD'S LIMITED AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Cities of Lehi, Cedar Hills, Highland, Alpine, American Fork, and Draper (the "Participating Cities") entered into an Interlocal Agreement pursuant to the Utah Interlocal Cooperation Act, Title 11, Chapter 13 of the Utah Code Annotated, for the purpose of coordinating the creation of a new public school district (the "District"); and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement established a Joint Board (the "Board") to provide temporary governance, in accordance with the powers granted under Utah law; and

WHEREAS, the Participating Cities also acted pursuant to Title 53G, Chapter 3, Part 6 of the Utah Code Annotated (Creation of New School Districts), resulting in the formal legal creation of the Central School District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code § 67-1a-6.7, any change to the name of a local entity must be certified by the Lieutenant Governor of the State of Utah through a statement; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution is intended to serve as the statement of the District's name change required under Utah Code § 67-1a-6.7; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it necessary and appropriate, within its statutory authority, to approve a name change from "Central School District" to "Aspen Peaks School District" to better reflect the identity, aspirations, and communities served by the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges that the elected Board of Education, once seated, will have full discretion to reaffirm, modify, or change the name of the District as they deem appropriate under applicable law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board for the Creation of a School District as follows:

Section 1. Approval of Name Change

The Board hereby approves changing the official name of the District from "Central School District" to "Aspen Peaks School District," effective immediately.

Section 2. Statement to Lieutenant Governor

This Resolution shall serve as the official statement of the District’s name change, as required by Utah Code § 67-1a-6.7. The Board directs that this Resolution, along with any additional documents required, be submitted to the Lieutenant Governor’s Office to certify the name change.

Section 3. Authority and Limitations

The Board affirms that this action is taken pursuant to its authority. The Board further acknowledges that the elected Board of Education shall have full discretion to reaffirm, modify, or change the name upon assuming office.

Section 4. Authorization to Take Necessary Actions


The Board Chair, Mark Johnson, is hereby authorized to sign and take all actions necessary to implement and submit the name change to the Lieutenant Governor’s Office for certification.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and shall remain valid until the authority of the Joint Board terminates upon the installation of the elected Board of Education.
