NOTICE OF AN IMPENDING BOUNDARY ACTION AND REQUEST FOR
CERTIFICATION BY THE CITY OF HYDE PARK, UTAH

To Lt Governor Deidre Henderson

Pursuant to the provisions of Utah Code, the City of Hyde Park, Cache County, Utah (the "City"), a body corporate and politic of the State of Utah, hereby gives notice to the Utah Lieutenant Governor, that on April 8, 2026, the City Council adopted a Resolution approving the adjustment of Hyde Park's common Boundary with North Logan.

Accompanying this Notice is a copy of the Resolution approving the Boundary Adjustment together with a copy of an approved final local entity plat showing the as-modified boundaries of the City, prepared and certified by a licensed surveyor and approved by the Utah County Surveyor consistent with §17- 23-20.

I hereby certify that the City of Hyde Park, Cache County, Utah, has completed all of the legal requirements necessary for the Boundary Adjustment herein described.

RESOLUTION 26 - 06

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING NORTH LOGAN CITY TO
ADJUST ITS COMMON BOUNDARY WITH HYDE PARK**

WHEREAS, the North Logan City Council has determined that it is the best interest of the City of North Logan, that certain properties be annexed into Hyde Park City and disconnected from North Logan City and thus requiring a boundary change to do so; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 24-20 was passed by the City Council to expressing North Logan City's intent to adjust its common boundary with Hyde Park on September 18, 2024; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted by the City Council to receive public input regarding this proposed boundary change on November 20, 2024; and

WHEREAS, *Utah Code 10-2-419, Boundary Adjustment – Notice and hearing -- Protest* allows for such boundary change when conditions stated therein are met; and

WHEREAS, the City Council remains committed to adjusting its common boundary with Hyde Park as outlined below.

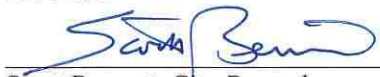
NOW THEREFORE be it resolved by the City Council of North Logan that it authorizes the adjustment of the common boundary of North Logan and Hyde Park as follows:

The following parcels shall be removed from North Logan City's corporate boundaries and included within Hyde Park City's corporate boundaries: Parcels 04-277-0004, 04-277-0005, 04-277-0006, 04-277-0007, and 04-277-0008. (See Exhibit A: Drawing)

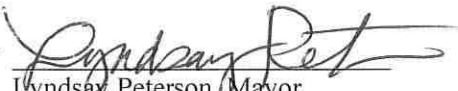
